

# Gardens as metaphor for the human condition

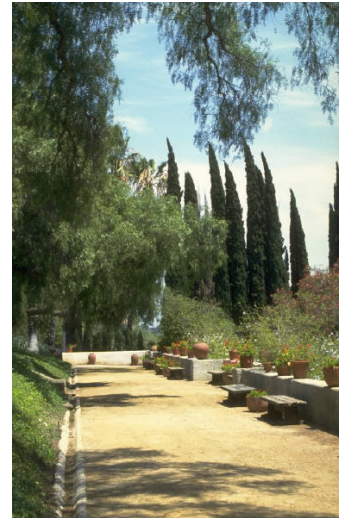
